TRTA RELEASES LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES FOR 89TH LEGISLATIVE SESSION Issues/priorities that matter most to TRS retirees:

- 1. Maintain a solvent TRS pension fund by fully funding statutory contribution rates and using excess state revenues to help reduce the unfunded liability.
- 2. Provide a benefit enhancement to offset the negative impact of inflation.
- 3. Maintain and protect TRS-Care by fully funding statutory contribution rates.
